Welcome back to school, we hope you all had a great break!

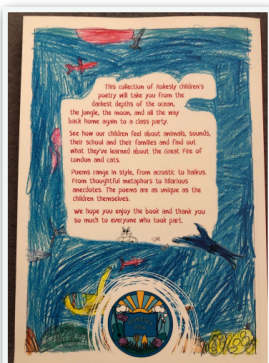
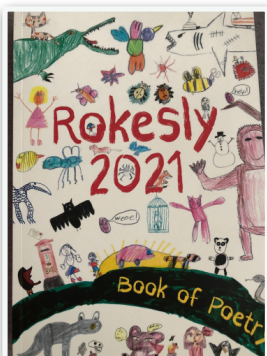
THANK YOU!
